


Year 3

Year 3 are learning about rocks as part of their science topic. We created posters to show our understanding of the 3 different rock types and presented them to our class.





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

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Year 4

They learnt what the three states of matter were and acted out how the particles are arranged in these. They were very quick at arranging themselves when the state was shouted out so hopefully it has now stuck in their heads! They are now looking forward to the next few Science lessons with experiments based on these.



Year 5

Year 5 have settled in well and have already been enjoying the extracurricular activities on offer, such as skipping to music and cross-country running. 5G went on their first swimming trip this week and 5P will be following in their footsteps next week! 
