E-Safety

With many children receiving new devices for Christmas, this is a timely reminder to monitor the settings and content on all devices that children are using at home. Please be aware that social media sites including Facebook, TikTok, Instagram and Snapchat are not appropriate for primary aged pupils. And finally...

- Jewellery is not permitted at school except for small, plain studs or very small hoops (little hoop earrings that 'hug' the earlobe) worn by children with pierced ears. Dangly earrings are not permitted.
- Simple watches only.
- Jewellery should not be worn on PE/swimming days unless ears have been recently pierced in which case they must be covered with tape.
- Long hair must be tied up/back for PE.
- Nails should be kept short; false/acrylic nails may not be worn in school.
- No make-up is permitted at school.
- The School will not be responsible for the loss or damage of any items of jewellery.


Year 3

- Our attendance level dropped to below national last week by 0.7%.
- Our overall attendance has decreased by 1.7% compared to the previous week. This is mainly due to low attendance in Reception and Year 1 classes last week (91% and 90% respectively).
- Year 3 remain the highest attending year group this week at 98%.
- Biggest improvement year 4 (95% to 96%).
